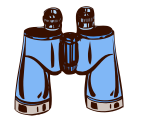

2. Bay Hill Rd

Scenic secret backroad - get your camera ready!

3. Coffee/Kites & More

Get the best coffee & danish in town, unique shopping and THE best taffy in Bodega Bay.

4. The Hidden Shipwreck

Legend tells the tale of an old potato boat getting stuck in the bay.

5. Hole in the Head / Campbell Cove

Hole in the Head:

This big crater is the remains of where a nuclear reactor would have been - a site locals now call "The Hole in the Head."

Campbell Cove: Sir Francis Drake is rumored to have landed here to repair his ship, the Golden Hind in June of 1579. Movie location for "I Know What You Did Last Summer."

6. Bodega Head: Take a scenic hike on your choice of 2 trails high above the Sonoma coast. Stand on the breathtaking Bodega Head once inhabited by the Coastal Indians. Filming location for "The Birds." **GORGEOUS VIEWS!**

7. Spud Point Marina/ Spud Point Crab Co.

Enjoy a delicious cup of chowder or your picnic lunch along with a view of the marina and bay.

BBQ lunch and a glass of wine along with a view of the bay.

9. Children's Bell Tower

A memorial dedicated to Nicholas Green using 140 bells given to his parents after donating his organs to 7 Italian families.

10. Arched Rock

An amazing photo spot of a beautiful rock formation featuring a hole.

11. Duncan's Landing

Great views and picnic area - when it's not windy). On the beach: Iron rings are still visible on some days where schooners once loaded lumber.

12. Shell Beach

Stretch your legs and take an easy walk along the Kortum Trail on a boardwalk path.

13. Goat Rock State Beach

Filming location for "The Goonies." A part of the Sonoma Coast State Beaches - the Russian River flows between Goat Rock Beach and Jenner Beach into the Pacific Ocean. The two beaches are a year round home to a colony of more than 300 California Harbor Seals. Stay on the berm and out of the water. Look for sea glass and take some pretty smooth rocks home for your garden.

14. Russian River Bridge

Take in the amazing view of the Russian River as we cross the bridge. Filming location for the movie, "Forever Young."

Other Favorite Locations/Activities:

Doran Beach:

201 Doran Beach Rd. (707) 875-3540. A 2-mile stretch of sandy beach popular for visitors to picnic, build sand castles, fly kites, surf, fish and stroll. A rock jetty at the harbor mouth provides access for fishing, crabbing and exploring sea life. Open sunrise to sunset. Although this is the SAFEST beach on the entire Sonoma coast, please mind the waves and be safe. Picnic tables available on the boardwalk with an amazing view of the ocean. Fee: \$7 per car.

Bird Walk Coastal Access Trail:

355 CA-1. (707) 875-3540. A revitalized salt water marsh adjacent to the Bird Walk that is home to thousands of birds throughout the year. Fee: \$7 per car.
